Behavioral Services

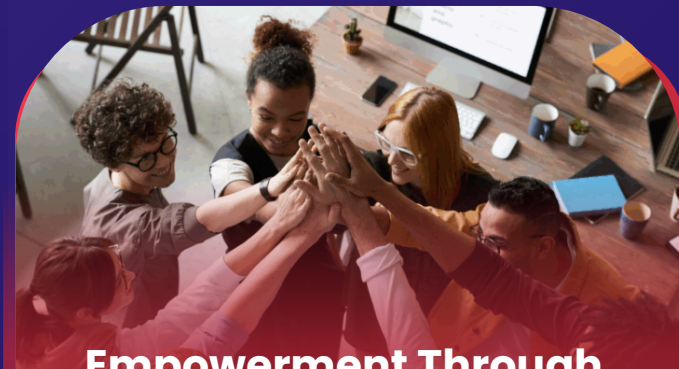
BCBA-supervised behavior support that builds communication, emotional regulation, and social well-being.
